Possible benefits include:

For **FAMILIES**

- Federal child tax benefit (up to \$569/month/child)
- Provincial child tax benefit (up to \$110/month/child)
- Child care subsidy

For **EVERYONE**

- GST/HST refunds
- Medication and health payment assistance
- Covid-19 assistance
- Low-income support

For **SENIORS**

- Old Age Security
- Seniors' Benefit
- Dental or optical support
- Nursing home, home adaptation, or rental living support

For **STUDENTS**

- Education tax credits and deductions
- Student loan interest deduction

Need help filing your taxes in Central Alberta?

If eligible, you can participate in the Community Volunteer Income Tax Program (CVITP)

| Eligibility for the CVITP | |
|--|---------------------------|
| Taxpayer status | Annual Household income |
| Single person | up to \$35,000 |
| Couple | up to \$45,000 |
| For each additional person, including children | \$2,500 additional income |

| CVITP cannot be accessed, if: |
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| You have self-employment income |
| You have business or rental income and expenses |
| You have capital gains or losses |
| You have interest income over \$1,000 |
| You have filed for bankruptcy in the past two years |
